



**Is your dog desexed?**  
If so, you qualify for a reduction on your Dog Registration Fee.



## What you need to do...

- a. Bring us a certificate from your vet to show proof that your dog is desexed  
**OR** - Take this form to your vet and ask them to stamp and sign it to verify that your dog is desexed  
**THEN** - Bring into the Invercargill City Council Administration Building in Esk Street and we'll do the rest.
- b. **OR** - Contact your vet and they can email us the required details at [animalcontrol@icc.govt.nz](mailto:animalcontrol@icc.govt.nz)
