

PUBLIC NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR RESOURCE CONSENT SECTIONS 2AB, 95A, 95C and 127 OF THE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ACT 1991

18 October 2018

The Invercargill City Council has received an application for resource consent from: HWCP Management Limited

The application is for the following activity:

- Demolish two Category II buildings and partial demolition and alteration of the façade of one Category II building listed on the Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga register.
- Demolish 13 Class 2 heritage buildings and retain the façade of three Class 2 heritage buildings.
- Removal of street furniture (kerbstones and verandah posts).
- Demolition of buildings with an area exceeding 120m²,
- Construct buildings which will not comply with the provisions of the Business 1 Zone,
- To establish residential activities,
- Breach noise limits during the demolition and construction phases,
- Undertake earthworks,
- To breach the queuing space requirement for vehicles.
- To construct a new access/egress off State Highway 1 (Tay Street).
- To carry out work in a potential HAIL site under the NES for Assessing and Managing Contaminants in Soil to Protect Human Health.

The location of the proposed activity is: **The block bounded by the east side of Dee**, south side of Esk, west side of Kelvin and north side of Tay Streets : 1 to 9, part of 29, 31 & 33 Dee Street, 29 to 67 Esk Street, 2-18 Kelvin Street, 4 to 64 Tay Street and 1 to 26 Cambridge Place (as outlined in figure 1 below)

- (a) adversely affects the environment; and
- (b) does not relate to the trade competition or the effects of trade competition
