**Contract No. 818 Invercargill City Council, Urban Pavement Rehabilitation
 Tweed Street – Pomona Street to Nelson Street
 Pavement Rehabilitation Works**

Dear Sir/Madam,

As you know, Fulton Hogan is currently undertaking repairs on behalf of our client the Invercargill City Council.

This work includes the dig out of the current road pavement, replacement of materials and reinstatement with Asphalt, we are also completing some drainage repairs – which has caused a couple of delays. Work is progressing well, but we are still approximately 3-4 weeks before we will be completed and the road opened again.

We are aware of the disruption this work will cause the school, the pupils and the bus companies. Safety is our first and foremost priority so there will have to be disruptions as we progress with our work.

PARKING – Marked in blue

The school side of the road parking will be as usual – however buses do have the right of way, do not park in bus zones.

You can park on the left hand side of Tweed street from Princes Street – however you **cannot** turn right onto Princes Street from Tweed Street. You will need to go down Elles Road, onto Teviot Street then up Princes Street.

You can park on Princes street – again, follow the instructions above.

You can park on Nelson Street – again, you **cannot** turn right onto Nelson from Tweed, you will need to go to Teviot Street, turn right onto Princes, turn down Ettrick Street and left onto Nelson.

Pomona Street is **NO PARKING**

DO NOT park on Tweed Street between Nelson and Princes Streets, this is reserved for buses **ONLY**. Do not park in zones marked with a circle and line.



PEDESTRIAN CROSSING – Marked in Yellow

The pedestrian crossing signals have been turned off to save confusion with the contra-flow traffic. We have placed signs warning motorists to watch for pedestrians.

There will only be traffic on the School side of the road (apart from our own construction movements or the residents). From Monday 4th of February, we will place a traffic controller between the hours of 8am-9am and 3pm – 4pm to ensure students can safely cross the road.

SITE ACCESS – Marked in Red

Our site is from Pomona Street to Nelson Street, please do not come from Morton Street and try to drive down Tweed Street through our site. This is incredibly dangerous and puts our crew in danger.


Please follow the signs and keep speed to 30km/h as posted.

We will need to close Nelson Street when we have finished placing aggregate in the trench we currently have open, at this point there will be no through traffic at all from Nelson Street.

Working hours on-site throughout construction will be between 7am – 7pm, Monday to Friday.
