



Application for Registration Under Food Act 2014

A food business with multi-sites, all in the Invercargill City Council area

The law requires that Council verify businesses registered under an MPI template Food Control Plan, unless the business chooses to operate the Food Control Plan in more than one Council District and/or predominantly wholesale their food. Businesses registered under a national programme may choose to select a verifier from the [MPI – Public Register](#).

1. What type of registration are you applying for?

In that case, this operator is the person responsible for the Food Control Plan and Appendix 1 is for the other businesses and addresses.

Collection of Personal Information

Pursuant to Principle 3 of the Privacy Act 1993, we advise that:

- Failure to provide the requested information is likely to result in a return of this application form to the applicant, and may ultimately result in a refusal to register, in accordance with Sections 54 and 57 or Sections 84 and 87, of the Food Act 2014, whichever applies; and
- Under Principles 6 and 7 of the Privacy Act 1993, you have the right of access to, and correction of, any personal information that you have provided.
