#### 5. COUNCIL INSURANCE

Mr Booth took the Committee through the Council Insurance Report. It was confirmed that Council's insurance covered councillors when formally on Council business. Mrs Hadley added that councillors were responsible for their own insurance 24/7 and that Council insurance was a layer on top, if councillors were on Council business and incurred an accident or a sickness at that time.

It was agreed that the inclusion of defamation/professional indemnity in the policy be investigated and that this be included on the action sheet.

Moved Cr Pottinger, seconded Cr Thomas and **RESOLVED** that the Council Insurance Report be received.

#### 6. RISK MANAGEMENT FRAMEWORK

Mr Cameron took the Committee through the Risk Management Framework Report. He informed the Committee that ICHL had adopted this framework.

Mr Cameron confirmed that Council currently did not have a Compliance, Fraud and Corruption Control Attestation. Mr Robertson suggested that this would be created through the Chief Executive driving it in conjunction with the Executive Leadership Team and she would be the collective owner of risk throughout the organisation.

Moved Cr Pottinger, seconded Cr Ludlow and **RESOLVED** that the Risk Management Framework report be received.
