ALEX LINDSAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants must either currently live in Southland or have resided in Southland for a substantial period of time.

The scholarship of \$1,000 is available to music students wishing to pursue advanced studies.

The scholarship is open to players of the violin or another string instrument or to players of other orchestral instruments.

The scholarship is available to pursue advanced studies.

The scholarship will only be awarded once to any individual.

The successful applicant will be required to undertake some form of community input using their music.

Alex Lindsay, distinguished violinist, conductor, orchestra leader and concert master of the NZBC (now New Zealand) Symphony Orchestra, was born in Invercargill, educated at Southland Boys' High School and served in the Navy during World War II. As a young man he studied at the Royal College of Music, London, where he gained the distinction of ARCM. He was awarded the MBE in 1958.

Mr Lindsay studied conducting at the Mozarteum Academy, Salzburg and had outstanding ability. As a violinist he had impeccable command of technique in every style of music and produced flawless tone. As a leader and concert master, he had a strong influence on the disciplined excellence of the NZBC Symphony Orchestra.

As a personality he was down to earth and practical in his views about what could be done to advance musical performance and appreciation in New Zealand.
