




INVERCARGILL CITY CENTRE

REPAINTING FUND

This fund offers financial assistance for repainting of recognised heritage buildings within the City Centre Heritage Area.



Details

Recognised heritage buildings include Heritage New Zealand listed buildings, as well as those identified as 'Locally Significant' in the Invercargill City District Plan.

Paint colours are to be in keeping with the era of the building and within the approved ICC Colour Palette for Heritage Buildings to qualify for funding. This palette consists of:

- Resene Heritage Colours
- Resene Whites & Neutrals
- Resene B55252 (A01-C40 range)

It is recommended that you contact ICC's Heritage & Urban Design Planner to discuss your project before starting work

The funding is retrospective and applies solely to building frontages (i.e. walls visible from the street). Funding is calculated at the following rates:

Scaffolding: 20% to a maximum of \$1500

Painting:

Building Façade (per storey): \$30.00 per lineal metre

Verandah: \$15.00 per lineal metre

Unique Characteristics: Council may also award greater contributions for the repainting of heritage buildings with unique characteristics, such as ornate decoration.

Application Process

After repainting is completed, fill out the application form (including proof of paid invoices, receipts, and photographic evidence of the completed work) and submit it to Council's Heritage & Urban Design Planner.

Applications for this fund will be considered twice a year (late March and late September) but are welcome to submit at any time. All applications will be acknowledged within five working days.

The City Centre Heritage Steering Group will consider applications at the applicable bi-monthly meeting.

Successful applicants will be notified within 5 working days of the decision.

The completed work will be inspected by a representative of Council before final payment is made.

Applicants agree that details of successful applications will be reported publicly at a Council meeting. They may also be used for publicity purposes.

How to Apply

Applications from tenants must have written approval and support from the building owner.

One application per building may be considered every 10 years.



Painting must have been completed within a year of the application date to be eligible.
