

Additional Pool at Splash Palace

What is the project?

Splash Palace includes a range of aquatic facilities, including pools, Hydroslides and sauna facilities.

The pool is well used by the public and currently meets the needs of the community however there are times of the day now that see the pool at capacity with the range of users seeking to exercise and remain healthy.

Invercargill's population is getting older. A new pool which includes additional accessibility features would make the pool more usable for more people in the community. It will also help alleviate the congestion at certain times of the day. Council will invest \$8.2 million in Splash Palace to extend the current facility to include a new 25m x 25m pool. Full scoping will be completed nearer to the time of delivery.

Why is council proposing this option?

Due to the increased usage and demand on current pool space, an additional pool will provide more space for all users of the pool. There will be an increase in the ability for Splash Palace to provide programmes. Splash Palace will be able to host national competitions without compromising the current level of service to the public, and in turn increase the number of visitors to the City.



When would it be delivered?

The project will be delivered by 2031.

How much will it cost?

The project is estimated to cost approximately \$8.2 million.
