



## **Proposed Road Stopping Notice**

The Invercargill City Council hereby gives notice that it has resolved to commence action to stop a portion of an encroachment onto road located at 33 Biggar Street, Invercargill measuring approximately 8m<sup>2</sup>.

### **Background**

The subject land is a portion of an encroachment onto road located at 33 Biggar Street, Invercargill measuring approximately 8m<sup>2</sup>. It is not formed and utilised as part of the road or footpath.

The subject area of road is not considered to be essential in terms of traffic safety, or pedestrian or utility access, and the land is not required for any other public purpose under Council's administration.

Therefore Council proposes to implement action to stop the road in order to facilitate disposal of the land to the adjoining landowners.

This notice is given pursuant to the provisions of Section 342 and the Tenth Schedule of the Local Government Act 1974. Any person wishing to object to the proposal should lodge their objection in writing before 4pm on the 31<sup>st</sup> of July 2023.
