HOW DO I TOP UP MY BEE CARD?

Use your Bee Card to tag on and off the bus. Wait for the beep and the green light, then you're ready to go.

When you've reached your destination, do the same again to tag off. If you don't tag off, you will be charged a default fare.



CONCESSIONS ARE EASY WITH BEE

If you're eligible for a concession, you'll need to have it loaded onto your Bee Card. Once your concession is loaded you'll get it automatically every time, without having to show ID to the driver.

Super Gold users will need a Bee Card to enjoy free travel.

Children under 5 years of age travel free and don't need a Bee Card.
