This fund will distribute up to \$565,000 each year across six funding rounds. The purpose is to provide a source of community funding to enable projects across the city.

This fund has the goal of supporting social, cultural, environmental and economic wellbeing as well as supporting the Council's vision to create "Our city with heart – He Ngākau Aroha".

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Current Year


The total funds available for the Community Wellbeing Fund is \$565,000 for the 2023-24 Financial Year. Three funding rounds have been completed with three more remaining.

The total funds allocated as at 31 December 2023 were \$334,226 plus one grant of \$3,600 was partially returned, leaving the amount left to be allocated to applications across the next three rounds at \$234,374.

Multi-year commitments (approved during previous financial years) for the 2023-24 Financial Year total \$99,700 and is incorporated in the funds allocated amount above.

All invoices have been paid from Round 1 and Round 3. One grant of \$2,500, from Round 2 remains outstanding. There have been two grants uplifted from the multi-year list to date.

Based on the above, there remains adequate allocation available to spend in Round 4 of this financial year on the requested applications according to the usual priorities of the Community Wellbeing Fund.



Next Year

The total funds available for the next 2024/25 Financial Year is standing at \$565,000 and will be finalised during Long Term Plan deliberations.

There are currently four multi-year commitments for the 2024-25 Financial Year.

Any remaining unspent funds at the end of any given financial year are <u>not</u> rolled over into the following financial year's allocation.
