Background

This fund will distribute up to \$565,000 each year across six funding rounds. The purpose is to provide a source of community funding to enable projects across the city.

This fund has the goal of supporting social, cultural, environmental and economic wellbeing as well as supporting the Council's vision to create "Our city with heart – He Ngākau Aroha".

Current Year

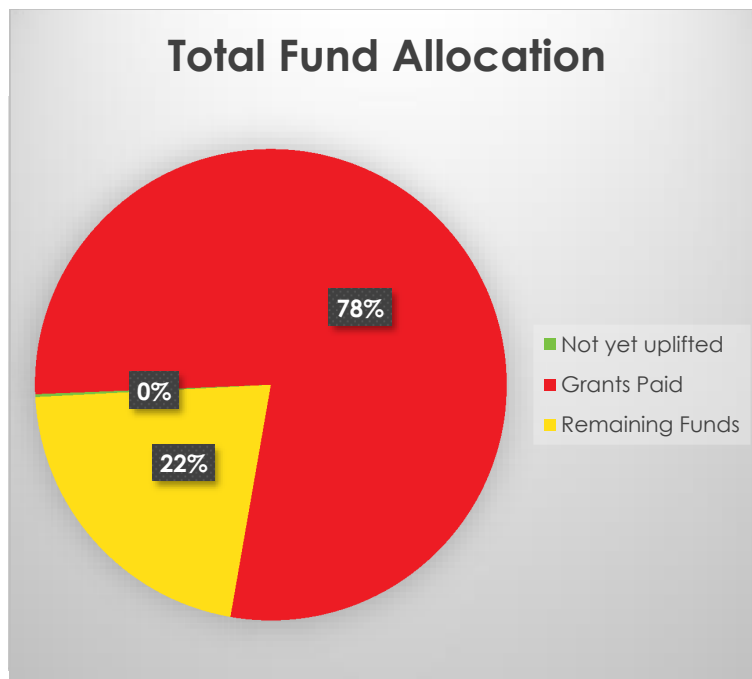
The total funds available for the Community Wellbeing Fund is \$565,000 for the 2023-2024 Financial Year. Five funding rounds have been completed with one more remaining.

The total funds allocated as at 30 April 2024 were \$469,090 plus one grant of \$3,600 was partially returned, leaving the amount left to be allocated to applications this round at \$99,510.

Multi-year commitments (approved during previous financial years) for the 2023-2024 Financial Year total \$69,700 less one amount not yet uplifted totalling of \$900. These amounts are incorporated in the funds allocated amount above.

All invoices have been paid from Rounds 1, 2, 2.1, 3, 3.2, 4 & 5. Total Grants uplifted to date \$468,190. There have been four grants uplifted from the Multiyear allocations to date. One multiyear application was removed by the committee at their meeting on 21 March 2024.

Based on the above, there remains allocation available to spend in Round 6 of this financial year on the requested applications according to the usual priorities of the Community Wellbeing Fund.



Next Year

The total funds available for the next 2024-2025 Financial Year will be \$565,000 as finalised during Long-term Plan deliberations.

There are currently seven multi-year commitments for the 2024-2025 Financial Year totalling \$86,900.

Note

Any remaining unspent funds at the end of any given financial year are not rolled over into the following financial year allocation.
