## APPLICATION FOR BUSKERS & STREET PERFORMERS

**Please Note:** The following conditions are to be followed:

- All sites must be safe for pedestrians and people with disabilities during the placement/removal of equipment during the performance.
- Any damage to footpaths, vehicle crossings, trees, road frontage, and street furniture must be immediately reported to the Road Corridor Manager.
- Street Performers cannot operate when activities or events are being held within the neighbouring properties or road reserve without the permission of the adjacent neighbouring business or property owners.
- The Applicant must ensure that the area used is kept clean and tidy before, during, and after a performance.
- Loudspeakers or amplifiers require special permission, strict conditions may apply in accordance with Section 326 of the Resource Management Act 1991/Noise Control Policy.
- Performances may take place on any day between 7am and 9pm which may be extended during organised events
- Performers are limited to a maximum total of 90 minutes, per location, per day. This includes performance, setup, and removal.
- If you are performing directly outside a retailer and you are breaking the code of conduct, you must move on if the retailer requests you to do so.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ALL THE CONDITIONS WILL RENDER THE PERMIT INVALID
