## **Inspections & Maintenance**

Monthly inspections

Illuminated & photoluminescent signs will be inspected to ensure they are

- · The correct type
- · Present and in the right locations
- Legible
- Performing as required e.g., illuminated signs are illuminating
- All dedicated light source positions remain unaltered and in working order and clean

## Annual inspections

Signs not required to be illuminated will be inspected to ensure they are

- The correct type
- Present and in the right locations
- Legible

Signs required to be illuminated will be tested to ensure they

 Remain illuminated in the event of a failure of the main lighting supply, for the same duration as required by Building Code Clause F6 Visibility in Escape Routes

## Reporting

The owner will keep records of all inspections, maintenance and repairs undertaken in the previous 24 months. These will be recorded in the on-site log book or electronically, which will remain available with the most recent compliance schedule, and as a minimum include

- Details of any inspection, test or preventative maintenance carried out, including dates, works undertaken, faults found, remedies applied and the person who performed the work.
- Form 12A provided annually by the IQP

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
