Invercargill City Council's Building Consent Authority (BCA) has allowed some building inspections to be carried out only by licenced building practitioners who hold the appropriate licence. These have been introduced in order to help alleviate the inspection waiting times. LBP's can now self-certify inspections for <u>Postline/Bracing, R1 single story with no tile showers or firewalls.</u>

A copy of this should also be retained on site for the next inspector to review. It is imperative that the licenced building practitioner calls for each inspection to be self-certified so we can confirm if there are any outstanding failed inspections and update the system.

**Please note:** rechecks will be required and charged for if there are outstanding items. Failure to do this may result in delays or <u>refusal of the Code Compliance Certificate (CCC)</u>. This also allows Council to carry out spot audits, so Council needs to be aware of when the work is to be carried out. (There will be no charge for an audit which will be on a random basis).
