

Terms and Conditions of Entry

By entering the Splash Palace Sports Competition, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

Eligibility

The competition is open to sports teams located in Invercargill and surrounding areas.

Participants must be students aged between 5 and 18 years.

Nominations are open to anyone on behalf of a sports team, including those in/involved with said team.

Competition Entry

Teams can enter the competition by emailing marketing@icc.govt.nz, commenting on our social media post (pinned) or by submitting an entry in person at Splash Palace reception.

Each entry must include the name of the sports team, what sets the team apart from others, and why they love their sport.

Entry Period

The competition opens on Wednesday 19 June, and closes at 5pm on Wednesday 26 June. Entries received after the closing date will not be considered.

Winner Selection

Entries will be reviewed by the Marketing team, Splash Palace management and the Sharks.

The winning team will be chosen based on the inspiring nature of their submission.

Prize

The winning sports team will receive a party at Splash Palace, including a meet-and-greet session with Southland Sharks players, swim passes for the entire team, and catering.

The party must be scheduled between Tuesday 2 July - Friday 5 July, and Tuesday 9 July - Wednesday 10 July, subject to the availability of the Southland Sharks players, during Splash Palace opening hours. The prize is non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or any other alternative.

If the winning team is unable to attend on any of the designated party days, we reserve the right to redraw a new winner from the remaining entries.

Announcement

The winning team will be announced on Thursday 27 June.

The winning team will be contacted directly by Splash Palace to arrange the details of the party.

Publicity

By entering the competition, participants agree to the use of their sports team's name, team name, and photos in any publicity material related to the competition.

The winning team may be required to participate in promotional activities, including photo opportunities with the Southland Sharks players which may be published across the Invercargill City Council and respective Splash Palace social media channels.

Liability

Splash Palace and the Southland Sharks will not be liable for any injury, loss, or damage arising from participation in the competition or use of the prize.

Standard Splash Palace entry conditions and guidelines apply.

Please note where promotions involve external parties or organisations, Invercargill City Council usual vetting and police checks have not been undertaken.

For large groups, a minimum ratio of adults to children is required to ensure adequate supervision and safety. Please refer to our current guidelines for specific requirements. Children must be accompanied by adults at all times during the meet-and-greet.

The maximum capacity for Splash Palace's meeting/function room in this instance is +/-20 people.
