



Application for Registration of a Food Control Plan or National Programme Food Act 2014

1. What type of registration are you applying for?

Help is available to find out where you fit. New Zealand Food Safety has developed a tool '[My Food Rules](#)' to help you work out the food safety rules that apply to your business or food activity. By answering a series of questions, you can find out if you need to register your business, who with (and under which legislation), and how to do it.

After you complete the tool, the answers you give in the tool help determine where your activity or business fits under legislation. It will tell you whether you have to operate under a

- MPI Template Food Control Plan: *Simply, Safe and Suitable*
- National Programme 3: *Higher Risk Businesses*
- National Programme 2: *Medium Risk Businesses*
- National Programme 1: *Lower Risk Businesses*

2. Who is the operator of the food business?

This section is for the owner or person in control of the food business. If you are applying for a National Programme registration, there can only be one business and operator. If you are applying for registration under the Template Food Control Plan, there can be different businesses under the same registration. In that case, this operator is the person responsible for the Food Control Plan and Appendix 1 is for the other businesses and addresses.

Collection of Personal Information

Pursuant to Principle 3 of the Privacy Act 1993, we advise that:
