Cr Soper apologised for lateness and arrived at 1.03 pm.

Mr Burdon also advised that he would abstain from voting on 'Application 1 – Conductive Education Southern – Lease of Premises' as he had a family member who worked for the organisation and the application pertained to operational costs that included salaries.

4. Financial Report for the Community Wellbeing Fund A5463582

Ms Crawford presented and gave an overview of the report.

She advised that there were currently five rounds remaining and that the Subcommittee had an average of \$91,360 to allocate to successful applications per round.

A question was raised regarding the decision for the Matariki Festival to not receive the multiyear grant for their 2024 event to which Ms Crawford advised that the money was returned to the funding pool and the funds had been reallocated to other applications.

Background

This fund will distribute up to \$565,000 each year across multiple funding rounds. The purpose is to provide a source of community funding to enable projects across the city.

This fund has the goal of supporting social, cultural, environmental and economic wellbeing as well as supporting the Council's vision to create "Our city with heart – He Ngākau Aroha".

Current Year


The total funds available for the Community Wellbeing Fund is \$565,000 for the 2024/25 Financial Year. One funding round has been completed with four more remaining.

The total funds allocated as at 31 August 2024 were \$189,940, leaving the amount left to be allocated to applications across the next five rounds at \$375,060.

Multi-year commitments (approved during previous financial years) for the 2024/25 Financial Year total \$108,200 and are incorporated in the funds allocated amount above.

All grant invoices have been paid in Round 1, except one which remains outstanding. Multiyear invoices are not yet uplifted as they are due later in the year and will be requested by the administrator.

Based on the above, there remains allocation available to spend in Round 2 of this financial year on the requested applications according to the usual priorities of the Community Wellbeing Fund.



Next Year

The total funds available for the next 2025/26 Financial Year will be determined during Annual Plan year two of the Long-term Plan.

There are currently \$96,300 multi-year commitments for the 2025/26 Financial Year.

Any remaining unspent funds at the end of any given financial year are **not** rolled over into the following financial year allocation.
