BURSARY

Applications are now invited from residents of the Bluff Ward for the Bluff Community Board Bursary. The purpose of the bursary is to facilitate and encourage the opportunities by which members of the community can undertake Tertiary or University education:

The bursary is \$2,000 per annum for three years for:

- (a) Candidates enrolled for a full-time course of study at University or other agreed establishment within New Zealand.
- (b) Candidates who are making applications for admission to a University or other agreed establishment within New Zealand to a full-time course of study in the coming year.

BURSARY

1. The purpose of the Bursary is to facilitate and encourage the opportunities by which members of the Bluff Community can undertake Tertiary or University Education.
2. One Bursary shall be offered annually.
3. The Bursary shall be selected from:
 - (a) Candidates enrolled for a full-time course of study at an University or other agreed establishment within New Zealand.
 - (b) Candidates who are making application for admission to a University or other agreed establishment within New Zealand to undertake a full-time course of study in the coming year.
4. The Bursary shall be open to candidates who have resided in the Bluff Ward for four (4) or more years.
5. The value of the Bursary shall be \$2,000 per annum.
6.
 - (a) The Bursary shall be tenable for three years and may be held concurrently with other outside scholarships or bursaries.
 - (b) The panel may grant an extension to allow for further studies subject to the applicant's progress and demands on the Bursary Fund.
 - (c) Where a change or termination of an approved course is proposed, the Board may impose such conditions as it considers reasonable upon the bursar in respect of a refund, or otherwise, of that year's bursary.
7. The Bursar will be selected each year by a selection panel comprising the Chairman and two members of the Bluff Community Board.
8. The panel may refrain from making an award if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.
9. Confirmation of the award of the bursary will be made when the panel has received verification of the Bursar's enrolment in the full-time course of University or other approved study.
10. Applicants may be required to attend a short interview.
11. The closing date for applications will be Wednesday 15th January 2025.
