This fund has the goal of supporting social, cultural, environmental and economic wellbeing as well as supporting the Council's vision to create "Our City with Heart – He Ngākau Aroha".

Current Year


The total funds available for the Community Wellbeing Fund is \$565,000 for the 2024-25 Financial Year. Two funding rounds have now been completed with three more remaining.

The total funds paid out as at 31 October 2024 were \$225,740, Plus one grant of \$20,000 was returned leaving the amount left to be allocated to applications across the next three rounds at \$251,060.

Multi-year commitments (approved during previous financial years) for the 2024-25 Financial Year total \$108,200 and are incorporated in the funds allocated amount above.

All grant invoices have been paid in Round 1 and Round 2. There have been one grant uplifted from the Multiyear commitments to date.

Based on the above, there remains allocation available to spend in Round 3 of this financial year on the requested applications according to the usual priorities of the Community Wellbeing Fund.



Next Year

The total funds available for the next 2025-26 Financial Year will be determined during Annual Plan year two of the Long-term Plan.

There are currently \$116,300 multi-year commitments for the 2025-26 Financial Year.

Note

Any remaining unspent funds at the end of any given financial year are **not** rolled over into the following financial year allocation.
